INITIATIVE, REFERENDUM, ANDRECALL OF THE CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE TO ALLOW A REFERENDUMPETITION ON ANY ZONING OR ANNEXATION ORDINANCE TO BE FILED WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS AFTER PASSAGE AND ANY SUCH ORDINANCE MAY NOT BE PASSED BY EMERGENCY. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Charter or Ohio Law, a Zoning Ordinance or Annexation Ordinance shall not become effective prior to sixty (60) days following its passage by Council, in order to afford an opportunity during that period for the filing of referendum petitions thereon. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Charter, no Zoning Ordinance or Annexation Ordinance shall be passed by Council on an emergency basis. "Zoning Ordinance" for purposes of this Section, means any legislation passed by Marysville City Council that changes the zoning classification or changes the use of property in the City. City of Marysville - Charter Amendment

TO ENACT ARTICLE XII, GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 12.10 TO PROHIBIT THE CREATION OFTAX INCREMENT FINANCING INCENTIVE DISTRICTS FOR DWELLING UNIT IMPROVEMENTS AND PROHIBIT DWELLING UNIT IMPROVEMENTS TO BE A PUBLIC PURPOSE WITHOUT APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EACH CITY, LOCAL, OR EXEMPTED VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT WITHIN THE TERRITORY.

Sec. 12.10. Prohibition of creation of Tax Increment Financing incentive districts for dwelling unit improvements and prohibition of dwelling unit improvements to be a public purpose without approval of the board of education of each city, local or exempted village school district within the territory of which the incentive district is or will be located. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Charter or Ohio Law, the Council shall not:(1) Declare an improvement to any parcel in the City to be a "public purpose," pursuant to Section 5709.40(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, or any provision of the Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 5709, as now exists or hereafter amended, if the improvement includes the construction or creation of one or more Dwelling Units:, or(2) Create an "incentive district", pursuant to Section 5709.40(C) of the Ohio Revised Code, or any other provision of the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5709, as now exists or hereafter amended, unless the Council limits the improvements in the "incentive district" so as to exclude the construction or creation of one or more Dwelling Units in the "incentive district" without first obtaining approval of the board of education of each city, local or exempted village school district within the territory of which the incentive district is or will be located. "Dwelling Unit" for purposes of Section 12.10 of this Charter, means any permanent building or portion thereof which is designated or used exclusively for residential occupancy including but not limited to, apartments, houses, town houses, retirement communities or condominiums, but does not include hotels or motels.

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER FOR INDICATING YOUR CHOICES ON A FEDERAL WRITE-IN ABSENTEE BALLOT (FWAB):

To complete a Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB), go to www.fvap.gov. You have the option of downloading a blank, hard copy FWAB to complete by hand, or proceeding through electronic completion of the FWAB using the website's FWAB Wizard.

The first page of the FWAB is a Voter Declaration/Affirmation you must complete in order for your ballot to count.

After completing the Voter Declaration/Affirmation, use the initial election notice issued on the 100th day before the election and the updated election notice issued on the 46th day before the election as a guide to:

- (1) write the name of each candidate or issue contest for which you are casting a vote and then
- (2) write the name of your choice of candidate or choice for or against an issue.

After you have completed the FWAB, you must PRINT the ballot and MAIL it to your county board of elections at this address: Union County Board of Elections, 835 E. 5th St, Suite A, Marysville, Ohio 43040.
